Dear Pastor,

Have you ever been in a situation where you were afraid to share the gospel? Maybe you were afraid about how the audience would react. Or possibly you were worried about how that audience might feel about you? The apostle Paul proclaimed in Romans 1:16, “For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.” Paul wasn’t afraid of the backlash that his audience would give him or about how they would feel towards him. As we know, he ended up going to prison multiple times and was martyred for boldly proclaiming the gospel. In our modern culture, many are afraid of being “canceled” or losing their position in culture and politics over the gospel. When Christians stick their neck out in the culture to share the gospel and gospel convictions, we should encourage them in continuing to boldly proclaim the gospel.
