Election Resources for Your Church

Dear Pastor,

At Wisconsin Family Council we have been working on a variety of resources that your church can use for the election this November. This week is the perfect time for you to look over our resources to see what would best serve your church. All of our resources are non-partisan. They are all in compliance with the 501(c3) tax codes, and as such, you can use any or all of them in your church as your leadership determines best. If your church has received any of our resources in the past, you will receive most of them for this fall unless you request us to discontinue mailing or emailing them. - **Voter Information Publication:** This non-partisan resource educates citizens on where the candidates for Wisconsin governor, Wisconsin US Senator, and Wisconsin Attorney General stand on important issues. This publication contains candidate statements taken from interviews, campaign websites, press releases, letters, and blogs/commentaries current as of publication. All sources are cited. Candidates are listed in ballot order. - **Honor God Bulletin Insert/Flyer:** Yesterday we mailed our Honor God Bulletin Insert/Flyer to every church that currently receives our monthly "Church Connection" and to several hundred other churches. This non-partisan and non-political insert provides five biblical reasons for why Christians should honor God with their vote. The publication also has general election information, with a link to the state's election website, where people can register to vote, find out where they vote, and more.
