MARCH 1

Pray the best possible leaders be elected to office. "Moreover thou shalt provide out of all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them, to be rulers..." (Ex. 18:21) Pray that believers will use their vote to bring God glory.

MARCH 2

Pray for God's forgiveness for when our country has failed to treat every human being, including the unborn and differently-abled, as fellow image-bearers. Pray our elected officials will honor life and pursue respect and civility.

MARCH 3

Give thanks for elected officials who believe biblical truth and pray
God will grant them godly wisdom and good counselors. Pray that
election candidates will exercise integrity in both their campaigns and
in their terms of office.

MARCH 4

Pray that God will grant strong faith to true believers who are in authority. Pray they will have boldness and courage to lead by example with radical, world-changing love.







MARCH 5

Pray for strength and encouragement for our leaders and election candidates. Pray they will make good decisions both in and out of the public eye.

MARCH 6

Thank God for uniquely gifting each of us and for gifting some with leadership ability to help govern our country.

MARCH 7

Pray that God will give us leaders who have a heart for seeking the Lord.

MARCH 8

Pray that God's people will vote for election candidates who will defend and promote pro-life values.

MARCH 9

Pray that we as God's people will humble ourselves, turn from our wicked ways, pray and seek God's face, Il Chronicles 7:14.

MARCH 10

Pray that God will revive His people and that we will rejoice in Him, Psalm 85:6. May God help us unite in prayer for a country that honors God.

MARCH 11

Confess that we too often have misplaced our hope, by trusting in our wealth and our status as a super-power to save us. God alone can satisfy and He alone is the Author of peace.

MARCH 12

"Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, saith the Lord of hosts," Zechariah 4:6. Pray that there will be a mighty work of God's Spirt across this land to bring genuine revival.

MARCH 13

Pray that the Lord will have mercy on our country which "calls evil good and good evil," Isaiah 5:20. Pray God will raise up leaders who will not compromise with evil, but will stand on the truth of God's Word.

MARCH 14

Pray that as elected officials assume their roles as God's ordained servants, they will use their authority to punish the evil and reward the good (Romans 13:1-5).







MARCH 15

Thank the Lord that as citizens in this country, we get to vote for those who govern. Pray that believers will vote in ways that reflect biblical values.

MARCH 16

Pray that in the midst of political, racial and church division, God's people will exemplify the message of peace in Christ Jesus, Who is the Prince of Peace.

MARCH 17

Pray that as a people we would recognize and acknowledge the truth that we are a nation under God, and that we will one day corporately and individually give an account to Him.

MARCH 18

Pray that our elected officials will choose to honor God and choose to live by His principles. "Them that honor me I will honor," (I Samuel 2:30), is God's message to His people.

MARCH 19

Pray that the Lord will give us leaders who uphold and defend God's plan for marriage and family. (Psalm 127:1).

MARCH 20

Pray that our elected officials will discern between good and evil, that we may lead quiet and peaceable lives (I Timothy 2:1-3).

MARCH 21

Pray that God will use the political process in our country to accomplish His Kingdom purposes and His will and that we will not allow the political process to compromise Kingdom values in our own hearts and lives (Matthew 6:10-13).

MARCH 22

Pray that Christian leaders in elected office will be a strong voice for truth and will take up the shield of faith in defense of religious liberty.

MARCH 23

Pray that God will work through believers to speak truth to our culture in the name of Jesus (Ephesians 6:19-20).

MARCH 24

Pray that as Christians we will always remember that our hope is in the Lord, and that we need to contend for the faith (Jude 3).

MARCH 25

Pray that God will open the hearts and minds of our fellow citizens to the truth of the gospel message, and that they will repent and turn to God (Acts 3:19).







MARCH 26

Pray that God's people will not just complain about politics, but that they will seek the Lord's direction about how to be salt and light for the political process. (Matthew 5:13-16).

MARCH 27

Our God is the giver of Divine Wisdom. Pray that present and future judges will make decisions that are in line with the truth of God's Word, and that His Word would be a recognized standard for justice in the courts of our land.

Pray that God's people will be unified in the truth of His Word and will testify to the world of God's love for them in Christ.

MARCH 29

Pray that racial harmony will exist in our churches and that the world would see the unity in our churches, and this will be a positive influence in our communities, schools and businesses. (Cf. Philippians 2:1-3). Pray that God will help us to listen to His voice of wisdom and truth above the political chatter.

MARCH 30

Pray for our governing authorities, whether you agree with or like them or not. Pray for our President, VP, Congress, Governors, state representative and senators, mayors, and law enforcement officers and judges. I Timothy 2:1-4.

Pray for the protection of election candidates and their families and also for those already in office.
