An Urgent Need

Dear Pastor,

If you have followed the work of Wisconsin Family Council at all, you know that one of the most exciting programs we have added is our teen worldview and leadership camp, LEAD Wisconsin. Organizationally, we have made the commitment to invest time, energy and resources in the next generation. And by all accounts LEAD Wisconsin is accomplishing its mission of equipping teens to become effective godly leaders who engage the culture from a biblical perspective. We started in-person LEAD WI camp in 2021 with 80 teens, which was the maximum we could accommodate that year. Last year, attendance jumped to 103, and this year we are anticipating a waiting list, as we are on track to max out at 138 teens joining us for this week of LEAD WI!

But there is an urgent need, and maybe you can help. We desperately need godly young people in the 19-25 year-old range who would be willing to give a week of their summer to minister to our campers as ADCs (aides de camp, aka "counselors"). We pay ADCs \$500 for the week of ministry, which is July 15-21, 2023. We also need volunteer chaperones (age 25 and up), as well as some who can serve as "lobbyists" (a 1-day commitment at the State Capitol on Wednesday of that week). Obviously, as the number of teens attending camp increases, we need more people to join our LEAD WI Crew.

We can think of few things as important as reaching the next generation with the truth of the gospel, a commitment to a biblical worldview, and the recognition that each of them has a God-planned destiny. We urgently need your help. Will you please help with this important need? Thank you!
