Today the campers are preparing for press conferences on the bills they are supporting and opposing. On Wednesday, we go to the Capitol for public hearings. Then on Thursday, we finish up with our worldview sessions with Carl Kerby with Reasons for Hope. We complete camp on Friday when the campers go to the Capitol to debate and vote on their bills.

Please join us in praying that every camper would

1. Have a relationship with Jesus Christ.
2. Develop a biblical worldview.
3. Become a godly leader.
4. Will be equipped to serve the Lord in whatever capacity He has for them, whether in government, in education, in business, in the arts, or some other area.

We want to inform you of a joint resolution in committee today. Our President, Julaine Appling, will be testifying in favor of Assembly Joint Resolution 60 on behalf of our sister organization Wisconsin Family Action. During the COVID crisis, many pastors were concerned about the government shutting down their worship services. This joint resolution would create a constitutional amendment that would protect places of worship from being closed by the government in the case of a state of emergency. If passed in this legislative session and the 2025-2026 legislative session, it would then go to the voters for ratification.
