### I agree to uphold the following general standards:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Neat, clean, modest, and activity-appropriate
- \_\_\_\_\_ No crude language or images on clothing
- \_\_\_\_\_ No tears, fraying, or inappropriate holes
- \_\_\_\_\_ Hats may not be worn during any sessions
- \_\_\_\_\_ Shirts must cover the lower back, midsection and bra (including straps)
- \_\_\_\_\_ No sheer, tight, low-cut or open-backed shirts
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tank tops must have straps at least 2" wide if worn alone (no spaghetti straps)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Shorts must be no shorter than 4" from the top of the knee
- \_\_\_\_\_ Skirts and dresses must reach the top of the knees at all times if no leggings are worn
- \_\_\_\_\_ If leggings are worn, skirts & dresses must be no shorter than 2" from the top of knee
- \_\_\_\_\_ No pajamas outside of dorm rooms
- \_\_\_\_\_ Capitol Attire and Camp Attire must comply with these general standards
- \_\_\_\_\_ Closed-toed shoes (required for Feats of Strength)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Clean, non-marking gym shoes required if using the gym for free-time

- \_\_\_\_\_ Professional pants, skirts, or dresses (i.e., no denim, corduroy, or cargo)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Professional top (no t-shirts)

- \_\_\_\_\_ Optional tights, leggings, nylons etc.
