## **Spring Non-Partisan Election**

Today is Election Day in Wisconsin! Every election day, I receive calls from pastors at the polls asking me about their ballot. I am at the Iowa Capitol today ministering to elected officials and won't be able to take such calls; however, you can go to <u>myvote.wi.gov</u> to view your ballot. You have until 8 p.m. to go to your local polling location to vote.

Spring Non-Partisan Elections have many different issues like local races for mayor, city council, town board, school board, local referendums, judicial seaor county board. This election there are two referendum questions on every ballot in the State of Wisconsin.

Summary of Question 1: A "yes" vote would ban government-run elections from receiving and using private funds. This wouldn't impact candidate spending or party groups but wouldn't allow for a political group to fund election efforts run by a municipal clerk's office. A "no" vote would maintain the status quo that would allow for a political group to help fund election efforts within a municipal clerk's office.

Summary of Question 2: A "yes" vote would ban political

organizations or agents from conducting the work of administering elections in Wisconsin. This would make it so that only election officials designated by Wisconsin law can administer our elections. A "no" vote would maintain the status quo that would allow for a political group or agent to aid in the administration of Wisconsin elections.
