Witnessing to the Truth

Have you reflected recently on why Jesus came into the world? When standing before Pilate, He declared, “For this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth,” (Jn. 18:37).

There is no way we can unpack all of the significance of this declaration, but consider just a few implications. First, clearly, there is such a thing as truth, and second, that truth is knowable. That is the whole point of bearing witness to it. Since this is the reason Jesus came, then it should be obvious that we should listen carefully to everything He says because it is the truth.

As His ambassadors, we are also to bear witness to the truth. Paul tasked Timothy with humbly correcting those who oppose the truth, with the prospect that God might grant them repentance, with the result that they would know the truth and come to their senses, II Tim 2:24-26.

We live in a day and age when people desperately need truth-tellers willing to stand up and speak the truth, even when they know it may not be well-received and even when they know it may be costly. People need the truth because it is the only thing that brings freedom from bondage, freedom from being ensnared by the devil.

What are some of the truths that people need to hear today? For sure, they need the truth that we are all sinners destined for a Christ-less eternity, but that Jesus paid the price for our sin and salvation is available for all who will trust and believe. They also need to hear the truth that unborn humans deserve life because they bear the image of God. They need to hear the truth about God’s good plan for marriage. They need to hear the truth that we are created male and female and that that is a very good thing. Denying one’s biological gender is an effort in futility and rebelling against creation order.

These are just some of the truths people are searching for! Thank you for all you do in speaking truth and in equipping your congregation to know and speak truth!

May God grant you a rock-solid belief in the truth of His infallible Word and in the Gospel’s saving power.
