“Founded in 1986, Wisconsin Family Council is the premier family policy council in Wisconsin. WFC is the only statewide organization in Wisconsin whose mission is protecting Judeo-Christian values by strengthening, preserving and promoting God’s plan for marriage, family, sanctity of life and religious liberty.

The vision of Wisconsin Family Council is a Wisconsin where God is honored, life is cherished, families thrive and religious freedom flourishes. That is a big vision, but it is consistent with how Jesus taught us to pray in Matthew 6:10, that God’s will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Wisconsin Family Council is more than just a para-church organization. They are a pro-church organization. Staff belong to and engage in local church ministry even as an organization they seek to be a resource and blessing to the churches in our state.

WFC’s Church Ambassador Network is a unique non-partisan ministry of connecting pastors to elected officials to form authentic, redemptive relationships. The LEAD Wisconsin camp is a week-long worldview and leadership camp for teens built on a civics and government platform, with over 325 teens attending in the last 4 years.

Resources that WFC provides to churches include a monthly “Church Connection” which serves to reinforce a biblical worldview relative to marriage, family, life and religious liberty; radio and podcast programming broadcast around the state; resources on current issues; educational information relative to elections; webinars dealing with current issues; and much more.

Ultimately, Wisconsin Family Council is about you, your family, your faith, and your freedom. WFC believes that real change happens from the bottom up, not from the top down. As churches and individuals are informed and involved in their communities, state, and nation, positive change that helps build and sustain strong families is truly possible.
