Question #1: "Eligibility to Vote"

"Shall section 1 of article III of the constitution, which deals with suffrage [voting], be amended to provide that only a United States citizen age 18 or older who resides in an election district may vote in an election for national, state, or local office or at a statewide or local referendum?"
